that list as being eligible for an appointment, it may 1 affect his practice to some extent, that a person may not 2 go to him because he figures, Well, there is no point in 3 taking my matter to him. He is probably going to be 4 appointed. Of course, it may be just the other way around,

some way go on purpose. MR, MILLER: I would have thought normally it would have said at least 30 days. In other words, under this provision, the nominating committee might come in just the day before the appointment ought to be made I have no convictions on it. I just want to understand it, and the reasons. I don't agree with your

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Miller, you couldn't say at least 30 days or 60 days because the vacancy may occur by death without previous notice, you see.

I can see that, but on the other MR. MILLER: hand, I can see no harm, why the nominating committee -- of course, usually there is a great deal of talk that goes around and whether it has been official or not, I think the politicking that my friend speaks of probably would be going on anyway. But I just wented clarification.
