

1 including the qualifications of lawyer members and of
2 their electors, shall be governed by Rule.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Any questions?

4 MR. BOND: Do the words, lawyer members, mean
5 all members of the Bar?

6 MR. MARTINEAU: We are leaving that for defini-
7 tion by Rule. We do not want to get to deciding in the
8 Constitution whether a man has to be a practicing lawyer
9 and if so, what a practicing lawyer means. I know
10 personally I have tried to draft something like that, and
11 it comes out in a horribly long and complicated provision.
12 We thought the best way to do it would be to let the
13 Supreme Court by Rule define what qualifications a person
14 who is admitted to the Bar must have to participate in
15 one of these elections if he equalified to sit as a
16 lawyer member of a commission.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Case?

18 MR. CASE: Mr. Martineau, I am wondering
19 whether any consideration is given to having the, this
20 definition provided by order of the court or something
21 other than Rule because as I see the word, Rule, aren't
