

1 in Section 7, would the Legislature have any power of
2 veto.

3 MR. CASE: I don't understand that.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Wouldn't Subparagraph 3 of
5 Section 7 be broad enough to embrace what Mr. Case is
6 talking about?

7 MR. CASE: That^{is}/the way I read it.

8 MR. MARTINEAU: I wouldn't think so. It would
9 be covered by the administration of the court where you
10 are speaking specifically about the election of judges.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Can we say on the basis of your
12 answer that the Committee intended that this rule would
13 not be subject to change by the Legislature and that
14 you will consider Mr. Case's suggestion?

15 MR. MARTINEAU: That is correct. We will re-
16 consider this, and if we feel a clarification is needed,
17 we will do so.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Satisfactory, Mr. Case?

19 MR. CASE: Yes.

20 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Mindel?
