

1 Nominating Commissions.

2 Lay members of the Appellate Courts Nominating  
3 Commission shall be appointed by the governor from the  
4 voters of the State. Lay members of each Trial Court  
5 Nominating Commission shall be chosen by the governor  
6 from the voters of the area for which such commission is  
7 established.

12 A nominating commission may act only on the  
13 concurrence of a majority of its current membership.

16 any public office of profit or office in a political  
17 party while a member of a commission and for six months  
18 thereafter. The members of a commission shall receive no  
19 compensation for their services.
