Committee has. I would think the public office referred
to would be only one under the State of Maryland under
the Constitution and Laws of the State of Maryland, be-
cause what you are afraid of is what you are trying to
prevent, is some action within the State by the Governor
with respect to some office of the State of Maryland.

MR. MILLER: Might not it be well to spell/out because I can conceive these prominent citizens, and they might get a call from some other jurisdiction, Federal or elsewhere for Federal office. He should not be barred from that.

MR. MARTINEAU: Let me take a quick poll from my Committee limiting it to the public offices of the State of Maryland.

THE CHAIRMAN: Might I suggest that this Con-, stitution couldn't prevent a person from taking office under the Federal Government?

MR. MILLER: Might not prevent it, but it could raise a question.

THE 'CHAIRMAN: Dr. Bard?

DR. BARD: I have the same concern in respect
