8 any public office of profit under the Constitution and  
9 Laws of the State of Maryland, or any of the political  
10 subdivisions thereof?

11 MR. MILLER: I am perfectly agreeable to it.  
12 Mr. Mitchell?

13 MR. MITCHELL: I am wondering if that would  
14 permit a congressman, United States congressman or  
15 senators to serve on a nominating committee?

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Martineau?

17 MR. MARTINEAU: Once again, I think that such  
18 an office would be a Federal office and wouldn't have  
19 anything to do with this Commission. My offhand opinion  
20 would be Yes.
