so-called political just as a position in a political 1 party is ruled out. I would not like, for instance, to 2 have ruled out our good friend, Andy, while he was not a 3 Member of this Committee, to be unable to be appointed a 4 Federal District judge because he served on the nominat-5 6 ing committee. THE CHAIRMAN: Your motion would read, in effect 7 any public office of profit under the Constitution and 8 Laws of the State of Maryland, or any of the political 9 10 subdivisions thereof? MR. MILLER: I am perfectly agreeable to it. 11 12 Mr. Mitchell? MR. MITCHELL: I em wondering if that would 13 permit a congressman, United States congressmen or 14 senators to serve on a nominating committee? 15 THE CHAIRMAN: Er. Martineau? 16 MR. MARTINEAU: Once again, I think that such 17 an office would be a Federal office and wouldn't have 18 enything to do with this Commission. My offhand opinion 19 20 would be Yes. THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comment? 21
