

1 to a Convention indicates we were split or a close vote.
2 Since the vote was not close and since the body of opinion
3 is not substantial here, I would disagree.

4 DR. BARD: I was going to say what she has
5 just said, but I would add this is it, not true our commen-
6 taries would give anygroup that sought an alternative
7 enough leads to fulfill it, so we would not be ignoring
8 the issue at all. I, too, believe that critical point
9 was that there is not a substantial group here, not a
10 group of any great significance here to want an alternative.

13 cut you off because I do not see how this Commission can
14 respond to the request of the Convention. I don't think
15 we would be in existence.
