

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Bothe?

2 MRS. BOTHE: I really don't see how any draft
3 can be made consistent with any of the views of the Com-
4 mittee or the Commission. It is literally asking to write
5 a death warrant to our entire Judiciary Article, and I
6 would just as soon have it a free for all at the Convention.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

8 Mr. Martineau?

9 MR. MARTINEAU: In reply to Mrs. Bothe, I
10 think the ingenuity of the plans and judicial selection
11 the only fault comes behind the Council, and we would
12 do it if forced to. I would urge very strongly as the
13 Chairman of the Committee that this motion not be adopted.
14 I think notwithstanding what our Reports say, but what
15 our comments say, the fact that the competitive election
16 would be contained in our Report as an alternative would
17 greatly weaken the proposal which we have just adopted
18 by a vote of 19 to 3 and which I can advise you if Mr.
19 and former Judge Walsh would have been here would have
20 21 to 3, because I have had written communication with
21 of them on this exact point.
