

1 and other type service. The Appellate judges are known
2 to the Court^{of} Appeal judges rather closely. They have had
3 appellate experience. They don't have to shoot from the
4 hip, and it is not so much of a strain on a retired judge.
5 The Members of the Bar are afraid, frankly, of the judicial
6 service on the trial level, by the judges who are retired.
7 It is an unhappy thing to have to give public expression
8 to this fear, but it is a deepseated fear and a strong
9 fear.

10 I think that the resolution of the issue by the
11 State Bar Association is a sensible one, and that in no
12 event should the Constitution provide for a seal of
13 executing machinery without legislation whereby retired
14 judges could be called back and allowed to sit in any
15 court of the State.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comment? Debate?
