3 that each judge notwithstanding the number of years of his
4 service will have to receive the same pension, so I think
5 we will have to --

6 MR. HARGROVE: Same rate?

7 MR. MARTINEAU: We will have to redraft that.

8 MR. MILLER: You are going to put in the same
9 principle?

10 MR. MARTINEAU: That is correct.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Any question?

12 Mrs. Freedlander?

13 MRS. FREEDLANDER: I was wondering if Mr.
14 Martineau would accept the removal of the word, same?

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Where?

16 MRS. FREEDLANDER: And just say, compensation be
17 paid.

18 MR. MARTINEAU: No, we want to have the same
19 compensation for all members of the court. They should
20 all receive the same salary. The problem is with pension.

21 MRS. FREEDLANDER: Wouldn't that be self-
