

1 to require the same, not the same pension, but a pension
2 for his widow. This is just as important, it seems to me,
3 to the judge, if not more so.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sayre?

5 MR. SAYRE: I think in this case where we
6 have any pension whether it is in Civil Service or in
7 a private company, and this is perhaps just a pension
8 as related to it, a survivor provision should be put in.
9 I don't think you could divorce one from the other.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Michener?

11 DR. MICHENER: On the continuation in office
12 and the nonreduction of compensation, I hope you won't
13 go through 29 again or go through the evaluation in this
14 country, but if such a thing should happen, this clause
15 might be very devastating. I do not see why it shouldn't
16 be in his term of office; and in the next election if he
17 doesn't care to have a reduced salary, he doesn't have to
18 run for office.

19 The other thing that comes from my background
20 of Social Security, I think it is a bad mistake to make
21 survivorship rights to the spouses and not provide for
