8 shall not be diminished during his continuance in office.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: That doesn't touch the point.
10 Mr. Brooks made. You are responding to Dr. Michener's
11 point.

12 DR. BURDETTE: Mr. Brooks' position, as I
13 understand it --

14 THE CHAIRMAN: -- doesn't answer the point,
15 I should say.

16 DR. BURDETTE: Mr. Brooks' position, as I
17 get it, is that you can't raise the salary.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes, you can. Mr. Brooks'
19 position is that you couldn't reduce the salaries of any
20 judges.
