6 and put an amendment to the Constitution amending this,
7 saying that nothing in the Constitution would prohibit
8 the imposition of a nondiscriminatory income tax on judges'
9 salary.

10 My query is, is that point taken care of, Mr.
11 Martineau, in your draft?

12 MR. MARTINEAU: It may well be it is not, and I
13 think we will have to determine whether such a provision
14 is necessary.

15 MR. CASE: I would certainly think it would be
16 desirable to put something in. As much as I love the
17 judges, I would hate to see them go along and not pay
18 their taxes.
