Contrary minded, no. The noes have it. Mr. Russell.

MR. RUSSELL: I move we adopt Section 1,

MRS. FREEDLANDER: Second.

THE CHAIRMAN: Ready for the question? All those in favor signify by saying aye, contrary, no.

Aves have it.

MR. RUSSELL: On Page 4, Section 2, Persons Eligible to Vote in Presidential Elections, any person who has been a resident of this State less than six months next preceding an election, but who is otherwise cligible to vote under this Article, may vote for presidential electors in such an election.

This section is new to the Maryland constitution but has been included in several other state constitutions in recent years. This is new to the Maryland constitution and the Commission, if I recall at the last meeting, approved it. However, since this whole section is being submitted in final form, we hope, we move that Section 2 be adopted as read.
