

1 Any person shall be allowed to speak, write
2 and publish his sentiments on all subjects, being res-
3 ponsible for the abuse of that privilege.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there any suggested change
5 or addition in that language?

6 MR. MITCHELL: Privilege to write, responsible
7 for the abuse of that right.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: I think the point here was, you
9 weren't here for the debate before, privilege is the
10 word in the present Declaration, and the effort here was
11 to use the old language, Mr. Mitchell. Now, read the
12 Committee's Section.

13 MR. GENTRY: It would read, Section 2, The
14 people shall have the right peaceably to assemble and to
15 petition the government for the redress of grievances.
16 Freedom of the press and freedom of speech shall not be
17 abridged, each person remaining responsible for abuse of
18 those privileges.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: All right, we will submit to the
20 vote the question whether the revised draft or the Committee
21 draft shall appear in the Committee Report, the other
