3 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Bard?

4 DR. BARD: In light of the question just asked,
5 would you be willing to go back and make it clear in
6 regard to the vote that just took place because I, for one,
7 was not clear nor was Mr. Mindel, and we voted the wrong
8 way.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: We will go back and do it by a
10 show of hands. If you will look at your draft, you will
11 see that the Committee draft has in the left margin opposite
12 the language the words, Proposed by Committee. Now, on
13 Section 1, a vote Aye is a vote for the revised draft
14 which appears on Page 2.

15 DR. JENKINS: This is what is confusing, is a
16 vote Aye as proposed by the Committee, or not?

17 THE CHAIRMAN: It is not. A vote of Aye is for
18 the revised draft on Page 2 including the first four lines
19 on Page 3. A vote No is a vote in favor of the Committee
20 draft which appears in the second paragraph on Page 3
21 and opposite are the words, Proposed by Committee.
