2 six lines on the page opposite which appears the notation,
3 Proposed by Committee, as amended with the rights instead
4 of privileges.

5 DR. BARD: May I ask the Committee whether it
6 would not be true that in amending their own proposal,
7 they should also have done so with the word, privilege,
8 in the original one?

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Well, I don't want to put that
10 to the Committee.

11 DR. BARD: But I would be more willing to vote
12 Aye on the basis of that statement.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: All right. Let me say this,
14 Dr. Bard, my suggestion to you was this, first off, the
15 Committee has used wherever possible the language of the
16 existing Declaration. The existing Declaration uses the
17 word, privilege. Therefore, that is why they had used
18 that word. If anybody desires to substitute language in
19 Section 2, we can put it to a vote or take consent. Does
20 that answer your question?
