

1 THE CHAIRMAN: I would not think so, but
2 Mr. Gentry, the question is whether a person includes the
3 press.

4 MR. GENTRY: I should think it would. It has
5 after all these years.

6 JUDGE ADKINS: What press was used in the old
7 times?

8 THE CHAIRMAN: But the press speaks through
9 persons, doesn't it, Judge?

10 JUDGE ADKINS: Usually speaks through a corpora-
11 tion.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes, but the corporation being
13 a person under the language we use. Now then, we will
14 proceed to Section 3.

15 Mr. Gentry?

16 MR. GENTRY: The Section 3, the first line of
17 which refers to the establishment clause.

18 No law shall be enacted respecting the estab-
19 lishment of religion.

20 Every man shall have the right to worship or
21 not to worship as he thinks most acceptable.
