

1 as the last clause of the Committee draft, so that the  
2 difference is in revised draft you have this language,  
3 Every man shall have the right to worship or not to worship  
4 as he thinks most acceptable. No person shall by any law  
5 be molested in his person or estate on account of his  
6 religious persuasion or profession or because of his  
7 religious practice or lack thereof. Whereas, in lieu of  
8 that, in the Committee draft you have the statement,  
9 No person shall be restricted in the free exercise of  
10 religious profession and worship. Are you ready for the  
11 question?

13 MRS. BOTHE: I know we don't want to prolong  
14 this or make a debate, but it was my recollection that at the  
15 last meeting, the phrase, worship or not to worship, was  
16 explicitly mandated to the Committee, not because of the  
17 additional language, but because of the sentiment expressed.  
18 Now, I don't know how to vote here because the language  
19 of Section 3 as placed there by the Committee is not the  
20 language I would vote for. However, I don't want to vote  
21 for Section, to the traditional language, either, and I
