Any discussion? THE CHAIRMAN: 1 Mr. Gentry? 2 MR. GENTRY: The Committee looked at this and 3 rejected it because we saw a great deal of problem in 4 words like, a man shall have a right not to worship. How 5 do you not worship in a manner you find most acceptable? 6 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sykes? 7 I move to amend Mrs. Bothe's motion MR. SYKES: 8 to make it read that the version proposed by the Committee, 9 the second sentence would read, No person would be res-10 tricted in the free exercise of religion, and that has 11 a traditional meaning which would make perfectly clear. 12 THE CHAIRMAN: Would you accept the amendment? 13 MRS. BOTHE: No, I would not. It does not make 14 it perfectly clear. 15 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Templeton? 16 DR. TEMPLETON: It may be a matter for the 17 Committée on Style, but would Mrs. Bothe consider making 18 that, no, every person shall have the right. Just for 19 consistency -- would you give that to the Committee on 20 21 Style?
