2 Mr. Gentry?

3 MR. GENTRY: The Committee looked at this and
4 rejected it because we saw a great deal of problem in
5 words like, a man shall have a right not to worship. How
6 do you not worship in a manner you find most acceptable?

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sykes?

8 MR. SYKES: I move to amend Mrs. Bothe's motion
9 to make it read that the version proposed by the Committee,
10 the second sentence would read, No person would be res-
11 tricted in the free exercise of religion, and that has
12 a traditional meaning which would make perfectly clear.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Would you accept the amendment?

14 MRS. BOTHE: No, I would not. It does not make
15 it perfectly clear.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Templeton?

17 DR. TEMPLETON: It may be a matter for the
18 Committee on Style, but would Mrs. Bothe consider making
19 that, no, every person shall have the right. Just for
20 consistency -- would you give that to the Committee on
21 Style?
