2 State of Maryland except for this kind of consideration.  
3 I don't think it is possible for us to complete a draft  
4 in a three-day meeting in October. I think we simply must  
5 have a longer period of time. I would submit to you the  
6 ideas suggested by Governor Lane that we have a week-long  
7 meeting, except for two things: Number one, I think that  
8 the difficulty of getting a group such as this with their  
9 many varied interests on this relatively short notice to  
10 be able to schedule a solid week would be enormous.

11           Secondly, I don't know how you all are, but I  
12 know myself that I have a feeling that our performance  
13 if it were chartered goes down with each lapsing day, and  
14 I think three days of this kind of intensive work is about  
15 the most that we can put in and meaningfully accomplish  
16 something. I would therefore suggest that we have two  
17 meetings in October, a three-day meeting over the weekend  
18 of our next regular meeting, that date everybody already  
19 has on the calendar, Monday, October 17. The second sug-  
20 gestion that we make is that we have a two-day session the
