MR. SCANLAN: The fifth report of the Committee, in effect the completion of our attempt to make recommendations concerning the organization of any constitutional convention. As you will recall, previous reports dealt with the basis of representation, the fact that the election should be nonpartisan, et cetera. This report is longer and contains a great deal of detail but I suppose in importance it isn't quite as important as the matters you have already approved.

The first matter that we dealt with and made a recommendation on in this report is the site of the convention. Following Mr. Eney's admonition, I am not going to summarize the considerable material
