be continued with the changes you suggest?

MR. CLAGETT: No, sir, I am not. The remainder of Article XIII, and the principal provisions that will remain after we delete from Article XI will be incorporated into our redraft, and Article XIII will not be separated and a distinct article. It will be a part of the new article dealing with local government.

THE CHAIRMAN: I understand that, but is the purpose of your motion that the substance of the present six sections of Article XIII be continued in the new Constitution, with the changes which you have indicated?

MR. CLAGETT: More accurately, it would be four sections and elimination of two sections. The two sections that would be eliminated would be any reference to a requirement of 10,000 white inhabitants and 400 square miles and boundaries of Wicomico County. That would be eliminated entirely.

THE CHAIRMAN: Which are the two sections you would eliminate?

MR. CLAGETT: With reference to Page 88, the bottom of Section 1.
