THE CHATIMAN: I understand that, but which are the two sections which you would eliminate completely?

MR. CLAGETT: And then Section 2 would be eliminated completely and Section 3, as appearing on Page 89, Section 5 and Section 6.

It might be simpler to simply recommend that we eliminate the whole article, except as incorporated in the redraft of it.

THE CHAIRMAN: Well, I think that doesn't require a motion, because none of the Constitution is continued except what is included in the new draft.

MR. CLAGETT: Fine. Then I will withdraw the suggestion of a motion and treat it in that manner and similarly treat Article XI(b), City of Baltimore Land Development and Redevelopment, and Article XI(c), Off Street Parking, and XI(d), Port Development.

There it is the thought of the Committee that this matter would be more properly contained in the Charter of the City of Baltimore or in statutory enactment by the General Assembly. The remainder of Article XI(a), XI(e) and XI(f), will be incorporated in our redraft, as suggested
