

1 THE CHAIRMAN: I understand that, but which are
2 the two sections which you would eliminate completely?

3 MR. CLAGETT: And then Section 2 would be
4 eliminated completely and Section 3, as appearing on Page
5 89, Section 5 and Section 6.

6 It might be simpler to simply recommend that we
7 eliminate the whole article, except as incorporated in the
8 redraft of it.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Well, I think that doesn't require
10 a motion, because none of the Constitution is continued
11 except what is included in the new draft.

12 MR. CLAGETT: Fine. Then I will withdraw the
13 suggestion of a motion and treat it in that manner and
14 similarly treat Article XI(b), City of Baltimore Land
15 Development and Redevelopment, and Article XI(c), Off
16 Street Parking, and XI(d), Port Development.

17 There it is the thought of the Committee that
18 this matter would be more properly contained in the Charter
19 of the City of Baltimore or in statutory enactment by the
20 General Assembly. The remainder of Article XI(a), XI(e)
21 and XI(f), will be incorporated in our redraft, as suggested
