I'll get the practice 4 of reading instead of -- The General Assembly shall provide 5 by law for the government of counties, cities and other 6 civil divisions, and for methods and procedures of creating, 7 incorporating, merging, consolidating, changing, and dis-8 solving civil divisions and altering their boundaries. 9 new county shall be created without the consent of a 10 majority of the votes cast by the qualified voters residing 11 within the area of the proposed county. The lines of no 12 county shall be changed without the consent of a majority 13 of the votes cast by the qualified voters residing within 14 the area proposed to be transferred from one county to 15 another. If the General Assembly wishes to change the lines 16 of more than three existing counties, this proposal shall 17 require the consent of a majority of the votes cast by the 18 qualified voters of the State rather than of the voters 19 residing within the areas proposed to be transferred from 20 one county to another. 21
