Baltimore City whether this statement would in any way endanger any of the relationships which urban communities have with the Federal Government in terms of Federal grants that are sometimes allocated to cities as such? MRS, KOSTRITSKY: That's entirely satisfactory to us. 6 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comment with reference 7 to Paragraph (a)? 8 MR. CLAGETT: That then means that we will have 9 24 counties in the State after this Constitution becomes 10 effective, one of which will be called the City of 11 Raltimore. 12 MR. DELLA: Who will select the name for the 13 county as such? 14 THE CHAIRMAN: We are not suggesting a change in 15 the name. It's simply Baltimore City, but it has the 16 status of a county. Is that correct, Mr. Clagett? 17 MR. CLAGETT: That's correct. Although, I might 18 say we debated that and we could find no answer to that, 19 just as the Judiciary Department was unsuccessful in 20 labelling its department members. 21
