Question is on the adoption of Section 3. All those in favor signify by saying aye. Contrary, no. So

MR. RUSSELL: Section 4. Disqualification.
No person shall be eligible to vote during such time as
he is adjudicated mentally incompetent; and the General
Assembly may by law exclude from voting those persons

This section is a revision reflecting the comments of the Commission at our previous meeting. We have added the word adjudicated mentally incompetent to set some firm standard and we provide here that the General Assembly should determine who shall be disqualified from voting as a result of conviction of crimes. The word serious the Committee debated a long time but we could not find a better adjective than serious. We submitted this in the form presented now.
