language, the answer would be yes. 1 I'm not asking about language. THE CHAIRMAN: 2 What is the intent? 3 MR, CLAGETT: The intent was -- the intent was 4 still yes. When the General Assembly began dealing with 5 more than three counties, we then felt it became a matter 6 of statewide concern and therefore should involve a state-7 wide referendum. Three or less --8 THE CHAIRMAN: Then I have to ask you another 9 question. Dealing with more than three counties in one 10 bill or in one section or in one term of the Legislature? 11 Which would you mean? 12 MR. CLAGETT: We would mean in one bill in one 13 term or one session of the Legislature. 14 Then, if that were so, wouldn't THE CHAIRMAN: 15 you be providing and easing the mechanics and avoiding the 16 problem by simply putting it in two bills? 17 MR. CLAGETT: You still have the protection by 18 referendum of the area affected. 19 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes, but I'm thinking of the
