THE CHAIRMAN: I would like to suggest, and I will not press the point if no one wants to so move, that the last sentence really doesn't add anything to the principle that you are seeking to establish, that if the acts of the Legislature are subject to the general referendum provision, that is, statewide referendum, I don't see the necessity of hampering the Legislature with a provision of this sort and having the compulsory referendum merely because it is dealing simultaneously with more than three

I am suggesting to you that you might be hampering very much the broad latitude you want to give to the Legislature in the first sentence.

MR. CLAGETT: I don't think there is any question about it, I quite agree, and the Committee is well aware of that, but nevertheless the Committee recommends, and again we are united in our recommendation here by reason of the fact, as I stated before, we had arrived at it by a process of compromise, and I do not feel free to give any yield on the point.
