MR. MILLER: I merely would like to suggest 1 that one of the points the Chairman mentioned might be 2 solved if the word existing were stricken and contiguous 3 were put in. That would at least insure there wouldn't be 4 a referendum unless there were three counties in one 5 6 package. THE CHAIRMAN: The word existing has been 7 stricken. Do you want to add the word contiguous, Mr. 8 Clagett? 9 MR. CLAGETT: I would have no ojbection to that 10 11 being added and I don't believe the members of the Committee would have any objection to that word, although it is 12 slightly different from what we had considered. 13 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sayre? 14 MR. SAYRE: In order to solve the problem, I 15 move that that last sentence be stricken. 16 17 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there a second? 18 MR. MARTINEAU: Seconded. THE CHAIRMAN: Any discussion? Mr. Brooks? 19 20 MR. BROOKS: I'll point out one thing, that the 21 fourth sentence does have a very significant limitation
