

1 MR. MILLER: I merely would like to suggest
2 that one of the points the Chairman mentioned might be
3 solved if the word existing were stricken and contiguous
4 were put in. That would at least insure there wouldn't be
5 a referendum unless there were three counties in one
6 package.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: The word existing has been
8 stricken. Do you want to add the word contiguous, Mr.
9 Clagett?

10 MR. CLAGETT: I would have no objection to that
11 being added and I don't believe the members of the Committee
12 would have any objection to that word, although it is
13 slightly different from what we had considered.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sayre?

15 MR. SAYRE: In order to solve the problem, I
16 move that that last sentence be stricken.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there a second?

18 MR. MARTINEAU: Seconded.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: Any discussion? Mr. Brooks?
