Legislature under this Section is soluble through inter-1 2 local cooperation, or do you mean to make the Legislature the judge of whether or not a situation exists when it's 3 4 proper to act under this Section? MR. CLAGETT: In the last analysis, Court ac-5 tion could be employed to protect the local areas from undue 6 interference by the General Assembly. 7 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Gentry? 8 MR. GENTRY: I just wanted to ask if the words 9 10 power to tax are broad enough to include the Port Authority rents and transit fares and bridge tolls and water and 11 12 sewer charges? 13 MR. CLAGETT: Yes. 14 MR. BOND: How about the power to borrow? 15 MR. CLAGETT: That would actually come within a 16 later section of this same Article, and I would like to hold that question until we get to that point, 17 18 THE CHAIRMAN: Judge Adkins? I'd like to ask, if I understand 19 JUDGE ADKINS: 20 this Section correctly, do I understand that the General 21 Assembly could create an appointive authority and grant to
