

1 Section, particularly the last sentence, you made reference  
2 and stated, I believe, that the General Assembly should have  
3 the power to grant the authorities, these authorities the  
4 power to collect taxes and revenues that might be imposed  
5 by the General Assembly.

6 I thought maybe there might be a distinction  
7 in that, because the revenues, such as receipts or charges  
8 for services might be distinguishable from taxes and my  
9 understanding of Judge Adkins' motion was that it was con-  
10 fined to taxes that were imposed by the General Assembly  
11 and that the authority to collect revenue was not subject  
12 to the Legislative limitations.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: I'm sorry, I didn't understand  
14 the motion in that way. I would have great difficulty in  
15 distinguishing between the two, I'm afraid, but I may have  
16 confused the Commission, so --

17 MR. MITCHELL: It seems to me there might be a  
18 difference. I'm not sure.

19 MR. CLAGETT: I think the Chairman has clarified  
20 rather than confuse, because I think the effect of the  
21 amendment would be simply to repeat what we've already said
