By that I mean, this allows 9 the Legislature to act on its own or, if it did not act, 10 one or more political subdivisions could request that it 11 act. We felt this was essential because perhaps the 12 Legislature may not act. 13 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sayre? 14 MR. SAYRE: That just doesn't say anything that 15 isn't said already by the first remark and the whole purpose 16 of the motion was on the very point that an authority is 17 not a government. If that distinction did not exist, there 18 would be no reason to have this in at all. . 19 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?
