ready for the question? The question arises on the motion to amend Paragraph (c) to provide that the General Assembly may provide, notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, for the creation of intergovernmental authorities to administer single- or multiple-purpose functions or services which transcend local boundaries and to add to that the last sentence as heretofore amended. All those in favor indicate by saying aye. Contrary, no. The ayes have it and it is so ordered.

Any further comment as to Paragraph (c)? Any further motion? All right, Paragraph (d).

MR. CLAGETT: In Paragraph (d), the county, city or civil division may agree to cooperate and share costs and responsibilities except as limited by general law. It is a furtherance of the provisions of (c), and I do not think would be materially affected by the amendment.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any questions? Mr. Mitchell?

MR. MITCHELL: This is a question of law. Suppose two counties got together and made an agreement creating a bi-county authority of some sort and then later,
