Mr. Sykes? 12 On that point, can I ask whether MR. SYKES: 13 any consideration was given to the rights, if any, of the 14 intergovernmental authorities to cooperate and agree with 15 other authorities and governments --16 Of other states? THE CHAIRMAN: 17 MR. SYKES: States and of other political sub-18 divisions in Maryland. 19 MRS, FREEDLANDER: Yes, in 12.01, or any other 20 governments. 21
