I take the reverse view also. What you're doing here is requiring adjudication for any declaration of incompetency in order to deprive him of the right to vote.

THE CHAIRMAN: Right.

MR. SAYRE: Is there any danger, I don't say it is in the voting area but there is a field of thought adjudication might ultimately be eliminated altogether as far as mental incompetency is concerned for hospitalization.

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THE CHAIRMAN; Adjudication in the same we use it today, yes.

MR. SAYRE: I wonder if this would hurt that forward progress.

THE CHAIRMAN: Might I suggest that the Committee take under advisement for further consideration possible change of this phrase either to have some language such as adjudicated or committed or perhaps to authorize the General Assembly to provide by law the means by which exclusion from voting on mental incompetency grounds could be determined.
