great deal of difficulty in spelling out in legislation the powers that you are denying. If you want to provide that the counties shall not have the power to legislate in matters such as we've been talking about, of private substantive law, statute of frauds and so forth, you would have an almost endless task to spell this out in legislation. Mr. Haile.

MR.NAILE: To explore that field further, the counties have the power of taxation and police power to enforce its regulations, generally speaking. In the field of taxation, i. Baltimore County, the General Assembly has already said we have the same power to tax that the General Assembly has to tax within Baltimore County by local law, except in the following areas and then they list about fifteen areas where we may not pass an ordinance imposing

So, that has been done in Montgomery County, too, and possibly a third county. It's a broad grant of power of taxation to a local government for local purposes, but a denial of that power in certain areas.
