that is set forth under that heading in our report. Obviously there are several places in this state where a convention could be conveniently held. But for reasons not only of convenience but of tradition, it was the unanimous view of our Committee that Annapolis had a clear command as the site of any. constitutional convention. I believe all previous Maryland conventions, constitutional conventions have been held there. It is centrally located, adequate facilities of every kind, and even though some states New Jersey, I believe Alaska, did have their convention at places other than their State Capital, generally the tradition in states is to have the convention in the State Capital. We see no reason for departing from that general policy in this case. We recommend to the Commission that it approve and so recommend in any enabling act that we ultimately submit to the General Assembly that Annapolis be the site of the
