Section be redirected to the Committee to prepare as an alternate or substitute a provision that the political subdivisions would have such powers as may be granted to them by the Legislature from time to time.

MRS. BOTHE: I fully appreciate the Committee's position and I certainly wouldn't even want to propose, I'm sure it would be defeated anyway, a motion that would strike at the heart of their work. I am concerned about the necessity for placing some constitutional limits on the county authority and I wonder if perhaps, if I withdrew the motion, with the consent of the Senator, the Committee could go back and see if they could draft some substitute for the second sentence which makes sense and which does impose a meaningful restriction on the type of laws which may be passed by a county.

I think it belongs in the Constitution and I think if the Committee closed up the model and started thinking independently, they might get the right language.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Gentry, would you consent to that?

MR. GENTRY: Yes, I will withdraw it.
