MR. MILLER: The population as in the last census.

THE CHAIRMAN: I think, so far as the Constitutional provision is concerned, the point is well taken, that the phrase, As determined in the most recent United States Government census, adds nothing and should be deleted. Dr. Templeton?

DR. TEMPLETON: May I ask two questions for clarification, please? In the second sentence, beginning, No county shall exempt itself, then it says, Provided, however -- now, I don't know what this means, No county may exempt itself from any general law, provided, however, and then we go into groupings. I wonder why that is one sentence? That's my first question.

My second question, there has been a lot of confusion about the number and size of classes. This says that -- with no less than any three counties in any one class and then the last sentence, it speaks about only one grouping of five or fewer classes. Those are my two questions of confusion.
