class, but if it does that, then in order for it to change, 1 that class must be eliminated and a new classification 2 agreed upon. So that, no more than one classification 3 shall be in existence at any one time. 4 Now, Mr. Clagett, I don't think THE CHAIRMAN: 5 you've answered the first question, and I would answer it, 6 I think, by saying there is no connection between the first 7 clause and the second clause in the second sentence, is В that correct? 9 MR. CLAGETT: I thought I had covered that in 10 the preface when I said actually I thought this was tenta-11 tive because we have not finalized --12 I mean just to answer his ques-THE CHAIRMAN: 13 tion, there is no connection between the two. 14 MR. CLAGETT: Your answer is correct. 15 THE CHAIRMAN: Now, Dr. Templeton? 16 DR. TEMPLETON: Now, I just heard it said, may 17 I state it outloud, if we can put a period after general 18 law and strike out, Provided however, that, have that 19 stricken and start a new sentence --20 That's the meaning, yes, sir.
