MR. BROOKS: The sentence, With population and such other, I think, could legitimately be covered by saying. Such criteria. It does give a preference insofar as the drafting is concerned. It doesn't give a limitation, but it does point out to anyone interested in the subject that this is a preface that is more commonly used, even though there may be some other legitimate reasons.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any other questions? Mr. Sykes? MR. SYKES: The use of the words, Upon such other criteria, in this draft throws this Section so wide open that the integrity of the classification system is destroyed and there will be ample opportunity for continued local legislation and the heart of what the Committee wants to achieve won't be achieved.
