

1 That is all I have.

2 THE CHAIRMAN: The Commission continues to be
3 plagued by lack of money, lack of personnel and lack of
4 time and perhaps the last is the most critical of all.
5 We are now about three and a half months behind the
6 schedule that we set for ourselves last February. Much
7 more important than that is that we are so close to the
8 time when we must have our Report completed that we can
9 accomplish it only by extraordinary effort.

10 The volume of the Commission's work, as all
11 of you know, has far exceeded anything that we anticipated,
12 and the most urgent need at the moment is for additional
13 professional help in trying to pull together in proper
14 form the various Committee Reports and memorandum to be
15 excluded in the Final Report of the Commission.

16 We have not yet tried to work out, and I haven't
17 suggested to the Commission as yet, any procedure for
18 the circulation of the Final Report and its approval by
19 the Commission. I think it is quite obvious from the
20 limited time left to us that we cannot possibly hope to
21 conclude our consideration of the individual Committee
