That is all I have.

THE CHAIRMAN: The Commission continues to be plagued by lack of money, lack of personnel and lack of time and perhaps the last is the most critical of all.

We are now about three and a half months behind the schedule that we set for ourselves last February. Much more important than that is that we are so close to the time when we must have our Report completed that we can accomplish it only by extraordinary effort.

The volume of the Commission's work, as all of you know, has far exceeded anything that we anticipated, and the most urgent need at the moment is for additional professional help in trying to pull together in proper form the various Committee Reports and memorandum to be excluded in the Final Report of the Commission.

We have not yet tried to work out, and I haven't suggested to the Commission as yet, any procedure for the circulation of the Final Report and its approval by the Commission. I think it is quite obvious from the limited time left to us that we cannot possibly hope to conclude our consideration of the individual Committee
