
going to be time for Nembers to prepare dissenting reports, if there should be any necessity for such, and I don't know that there is and would hope that there is not, but I have no doubt that there will be positions or final recommendations taken in the Report as to which various Members will feel strongly enough that they will want to note their dissent, at least on that particular matter.

Thinking about how this could be best accomplished, one thought that has occurred to me that is used in other instances would be to have in effect footnote dissents, where a particular statement or recommendation is made in the Report, and any Member or Members desiring to indicate their dissent therefrom, without the necessity of spelling out all the reasons for it, simply do it in the footnote. You just put a footnote and say, Messrs. So-and-So, or Mrs. So-and-So, dissent or have a different view.

There may, of course, be other methods, and there may be better methods. There may be some matters on which Members or a group of Members feel strongly and
