

1 going to be time for Members to prepare dissenting re-  
2 ports, if there should be any necessity for such, and  
3 I don't know that there is and would hope that there is  
4 not, but I have no doubt that there will be positions  
5 or final recommendations taken in the Report as to which  
6 various Members will feel strongly enough that they will  
7 want to note their dissent, at least on that particular  
8 matter.

9 Thinking about how this could be best accom-  
10 plished, one thought that has occurred to me that is  
11 used in other instances would be to have in effect foot-  
12 note dissents, where a particular statement or recommenda-  
13 tion is made in the Report, and any Member or Members  
14 desiring to indicate their dissent therefrom, without  
15 the necessity of spelling out all the reasons for it,  
16 simply do it in the footnote. You just put a footnote  
17 and say, Messrs. So-and-So, or Mrs. So-and-So, dissent  
18 or have a different view.

19 There may, of course, be other methods, and  
20 there may be better methods. There may be some matters  
21 on which Members or a group of Members feel strongly and
